On Saturday officers from [Essex Police - Harlow District](#) community policing team conducted a hi vis patrol of Harlow town centre. This was to target High Harm in the Town Centre, proactive operation conducted in High Street focussing on licenced premises utilising knife arch at The Clockhouse.

The results from this are:

- 2 suspects arrested one for Concerned in the supply and another for Offensive weapon (locking knife found during stop search).
- 1 knife found discarded in the Town area.
- 1x Cannabis Community resolution
- 1x Possession of Class A who will be cautioned

Also various stop searches were completed on the night. All in all a very good nights work around the Town Centre.

OUR CHIEF INSPECTOR PAUL AUSTIN TALKING ABOUT TOP PRIORITY



Chief Inspector Paul Austin, District Commander for Harlow, says reducing violence in and around the town centre continues to be his top priority. To tackle the problem, his team launched Operation Tarantula, targeting 13 individuals who are known to be habitual knife carriers with histories of violence.

The team have been working to divert them away from crime but for those not willing to engage, they have taken enforcement action.

As a result, five of the 13 are now serving prison sentences.

****Arrested and Charged****

Officers from Harlow Town Centre Team attended an address in Harlow after a report of domestic abuse between the suspect and his elderly parents. The suspect was arrested, which gave his elderly parents a chance to talk about what had happened. Despite being in his nineties, the father provided a statement which catalogued the abuse at the hands of his son. His mother was not able to provide a statement due to advancing dementia.

While at the address, the attending officers have found drugs with an estimated street value of

£7,500.

PC Emily Cross, of Harlow Town Centre Team said 'The moving and honest statement from the elderly victim was critical in providing enough evidence to secure the charge. PC Stephens stated 'The seizure of the drugs is an additional bonus taking more class A off the streets of Essex' The suspect went on to be charged and remanded and will be sent before a court.

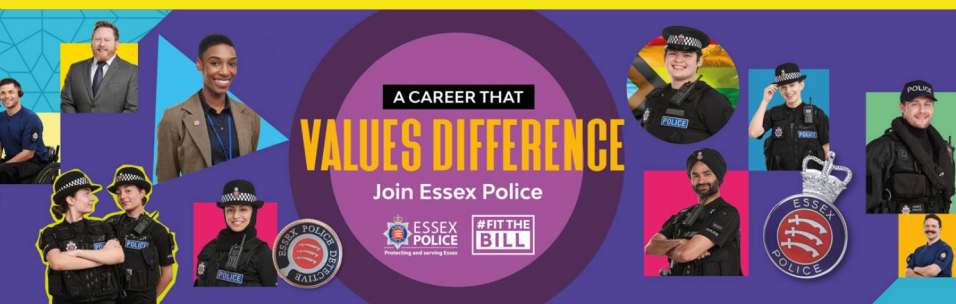
